#### A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

I take great pleasure in extending a brief outline of what is a Community League. A community league is an autonomous body, registered under The Societies Act with the Corporate Registry of the Government of Alberta. Therefore, it must have a properly elected board of directors Including committee chairpersons responsible for carrying out the business of the league. Each community league is required by the Societies Act to prepare and approve a set of bylaws which govern how the league is to operate.

Any resident with the boundaries of the community may become a member. Membership must be voluntary for the association to recognized as a community league.

A league's members ar responsible for electing a board of directors, which is responsible for overall operation of the league . Each league is required to hold an annual general meeting where directors are elected and financial statements reviewed.

Residents of the Killarney Community league area welcome to become members and become active participants in League activities.
