Therefore, it must have a properly elected board of directors including committee chair persons responsible for carrying out the business of the league. Each community league is required by the Societies Act to prepare and approve a set of bylaws which govern how the league is to operate. Any resident within the boundaries of the community may become a member. Membership must be voluntary for the association to be recognized as a community league. All league's members are responsible for electing a board of directors, which is responsible for overall operation of the league. Each league is required to hold an annual general meeting where directors are elected and financial statements reviewed. Residents of the Killarney Community league are welcome to become members and become active participants in League activities.
